

Sweet Treat Mini Gift Bags

Make easy, one-of-a-kind gift bags with cute and colorful craft supplies.



You will need:

- American Girl Crafts Sweet Stacked Stickers (30-231481)
- American Girl Crafts Tiny Letters Bubble Stickers (30-231641)
- American Girl Crafts Tiny Letters Glitter Stickers (30-231542)
- American Girl Crafts Star Border Punch (30-559936)
- American Girl Crafts Stencil Ruler (30-154605)
- American Girl Crafts Scissors (30-154582)
- American Girl Crafts Glue (30-154650)
- 2 mini gift bags
- 1 sheet of white paper
- ribbon
- hole punch

Before you begin: Glue can be messy, so cover your work space with newspaper or scrap paper.

For the “Celebrate” bag:

- 1 Fold the top of your gift bag over toward the front of the bag. Choose 2 stickers from the Sweet Stacked Stickers and press them to the front lower half of the bag.
- 2 Measure and cut a strip of white paper that is as wide as your bag and 1½ inches tall. Use the Star Border Punch to make a design on the white paper. Glue the solid edge of the strip to the underside of the folded flap so that the stars show.
- 3 Use the Tiny Letters Bubble Stickers to spell out “Celebrate” on the front of the folded flap.
- 4 Unfold the flap, open the bag and fill with goodies or a small gift. Refold and punch 2 holes near the top of the bag.
- 5 Measure and cut 5 inches of ribbon. Thread the ribbon ends through the holes and tie in a knot.

For the name bag:

- 1 Fold the top of your gift bag over toward the front of the bag. Press one sticker from the Sweet Stacked Stickers to the front lower half of the bag.
- 2 Use the Tiny Letters Glitter Stickers to spell out the name of the recipient or another fun word. Stick the letters and other small, glittery designs to the lower half of the bag.
- 3 Unfold the flap, open the bag and fill with goodies or a small gift. Refold and punch one hole near the top center of the bag.
- 4 Measure and cut 10 inches of ribbon. Thread the ribbon through the hole and tie in a bow.
