

Cord Bracelets

Bead and tie colorful bracelets for you and your friends!




You will need:

- American Girl Crafts Colored Cotton Cording (30-248465)
- American Girl Crafts Charm Beads (30-155671)
- American Girl Crafts Painted Beads (30-248472)

Show your style!

1  Choose a color from the Colored Cotton Cording and ask an adult to help you cut 22 to 28 inches of cord. The more knots you make in your bracelet, the more cord you'll need.

2 Choose a large bead from the Painted Beads. This will be your toggle bead. A toggle is part of the closure to a bracelet.

3 Fold your length of cord in half. Tie a knot in the folded end to form a loop. Make sure your loop is large enough to fit over your toggle bead.

4 Begin stringing whatever beads or charms you like onto either strand of the cord, tying both strands together into one knot after each bead.

5  When the bracelet fits around your wrist, string the toggle bead over one of the cords. Ask an adult to help you tie both cords together in a double-knot above the toggle bead.

6 Pull the toggle through the loop. Let your style shine!
