

Friendship Card

Create your own greeting card for a very special friend!



Before you begin: Glue can be messy, so cover your work space with newspaper or scrap paper.

1 Pick 2 Sheets of patterned paper from the Super Paper Pad. Choose one sheet to be the base of your card, and cut a rectangle 10½ inches long and 4¼ inches wide. Fold the rectangle in half lengthwise. This will be your card with the fold at the top.

2 Cut your second piece of paper in a rectangle 4¾ inches long and 4 inches wide. Center and glue the rectangle to the front of your folded card.

3 Peel the “True-blue Friends” sticker from the Friendship Stacked Stickers, and press it firmly to the center of your card. Remember, the fold is at the top of the card, so make sure you place the sticker correctly.

You will need:

- American Girl Crafts 12x12 Super Paper Pad (30-231726)
- American Girl Crafts Friendship Stacked Stickers (30-231511)
- American Girl Crafts Logo Tiny Designs Tape (30-231580)
- American Girl Crafts Glue (30-154650)
- American Girl Crafts Scissors (30-154582)
- adhesive foam squares

4 Cut a piece of the Tiny Designs Tape to 4¼ inches long. Try to include each whole word, “Smile,” “Shine” and “Friends,” leaving a star at each end. Press the tape firmly to a piece of plain white paper. (Hint: Use a scrap from the patterned paper, which is white on the back.) Trim around the edge of the tape to make a long, white rectangle.

5 Stick 4 adhesive foam squares along the back of the rectangle. Then stick the entire rectangle to the front of the card, about ½ inch from the bottom.

6 Write a special note inside to your friend!
